Program Overview:

Wah Mei provides a bilingual (Cantonese & English) enrichment summer camp program that is open to all students. We offer children the opportunity to expand their language capabilities during a fun-filled summer experience. Our activities include thematic project-based learning that keeps children's minds active throughout the summer. Our Program takes place on **1555** Irving Street, San Francisco, **94122**.

Program Options:

Our 2024 Wah Mei Summer Camp program will run from 8:30 AM - 5:30 PM. It costs \$2600 if you sign up for all 8 weeks, or \$1350 for a 4 week session. An Early Bird Discount will be applied if you apply for **BOTH** session A and B before April 30, 2024. To apply for our Summer Camp please include **a nonrefundable \$50** application fee and a \$200 deposit at time of registration. The \$200 deposit will go towards your child's total tuition cost. The remainder of your child/children's tuition fees will be due upon confirmation of the program. Please check

The responses below are intended to provide basic information and important policies. Please note this FAQ form is subject to change.

Program Logistics:

How Do I Apply?

Wah Mei Summer Camp enrollment packets can be requested by email (please email summer@wahmei.org). The Wah Mei Summer Camp program will be open to all surrounding communities. After you have submitted an application you will be notified when your child/children are accepted in a confirmation email.

What is the last day to turn in applications?

The application deadline will be on May 17, 2024 at 5 PM. Any applications turned in after this date will be placed on a waiting list.

When does 2024 WMS Summer Camp take place?

Wah Mei Summer Camp will take place in two (2) sessions:

Session A & B: (Full 8 weeks)

Session A: (4 weeks) Session B: (4 weeks)

Please refer to the registration form for the selectable sessions your child/children will attend our program. Our Summer camp will be closed on <u>Wednesday, June 19th,</u>

2024 in observance of Juneteenth and closed on <u>Thursday, July 4th, 2024</u> in observance of Independence Day.

This year to better serve families our program hours have been extended. Our Summer Camp will run from **8:30 AM to 5:30 PM**.



Where does WMS Summer Camp take place?

Wah Mei School Summer Camp will take place at 1555 Irving Street, San Francisco 94122.

What age/grade does the Wah Mei Summer Camp program accept?

Wah Mei Summer Camp program will serve incoming 1st graders to incoming 6th graders participants.

Will there be a Summer Together Initiative for Summer 2024?

The Summer Together Initiative is a City sponsored Summer Camp opportunity for all SFUSD students to which began in Summer 2021. As of publication date, DCYF has not informed Wah Mei School if they can provide any funds to us for Summer 2024. If Wah Mei School is able to acquire any funds we may be able to offer discounted rates and/or financial assistance to our families. We will keep you informed as progress is made.

Program Cost and Payments:

To apply for our Summer Camp please include a **nonrefundable** \$50 application fee and a \$200 deposit at time of registration. The \$200 deposit will go towards your child's total tuition cost. An Early Bird Discount will be applied to your tuition cost if you apply for both session A and B by April 30, 2024. Upon confirmation of your child/children's placement in the program the rest of the tuition fees will be due.

Refund Policy:

If we are unable to place your child in our Summer Camp we will be able to refund your \$200 registration fee but not the non-refundable \$50 application fee. After you have been confirmed in the program we will enforce the following refund policy:

- 75% refund of total tuition fees if parents/guardians notify us 45 days prior to your child/children's program start date.
- 50% refund of total tuition fees if parents/guardians notify us 30 days prior to your child/children's program start date.
- You will not be eligible for a refund if you notify us 29 days or less before the start of your program date.
- Partial refund will not be given for drop out of the program

Under no circumstances, will Wah Mei Summer Camp refund families who decide to drop out of the program prematurely.



Early Pickups

Frequent early picks up can be disruptive to program activities and coordination of early pickups is a logistical challenge. If you sign your child/children up for the program please plan to pick up during the designated pick up time from 4:30 PM to 5:30 PM.

Early pickups for other extracurricular activities will not be excused and may result in expulsion from the program without a refund. Excusable early pickups for doctor appointments and family emergencies are acceptable.

Financial Aid:

Absence Policy:

Wah Mei School believes that daily participation in our Summer Camp is vital to children and youth's development. Peer bonds, adult:child interactions, field trips, and high engagement and stability are hallmarks of our Camp. Participants are highly encouraged to be present and participate regularly. Participants that have inconsistent attendance may warrant a Parent Conference.

Participants that have **more than three (3) unexcused absences** in a single session, may jeopardize their place in the program. Staying fully engaged in Summer Camp will ensure that we can develop healthy bonds with your child and that they can fully enjoy all program activities. Allowed excuses for absences include doctor appointments and family emergencies with prior notification.

If your family is deciding to take a vacation during the summer please make sure that it does not interfere with our Summer Camp dates. Vacations will not be considered an excused absence from the program and if your child accumulates (3) unexcused absences due to taking a vacation their placement in the program may be jeopardized and can lead to expulsion without a refund.



Drop off or late pick up

Drop off time will begin at 8:30 AM parents/guardians can drop off their child/children at this time. Wah Mei Summer Camp programming will begin at 9:30 AM. Please ensure that you drop off your child on time so that your child can be fully present and to avoid disruption of program activities.

Program activities end at 4:30 PM, between 4:30 PM - 5:30 PM is pick up hour. Late fees will accrue **every minute after 5:30 PM at \$5 per minute** per child.

Who can pick up my child?

Any authorized person over the age of 16. Parents/guardians must include all authorized family members on the registration form.

What if my child is sick?

It is requested that participants who are unable to attend Wah Mei Summer Camp or have special scheduling requirements, are to email summer@wahmei.org. For "day of" absences notification, please notify the site manager as soon as possible.

Due to health and safety regulations, if your child is sick we will assess the state of their health before returning to the program. For children who are ill during the program, staff will call the parent/guardian for pick up. Any emergencies will be handled accordingly to ensure the health and safety of the child.

COVID-19 Health and Safety Considerations

Due to the ever-changing circumstances of the pandemic as it relates to our Summer Camp and all other programs. Wah Mei School is committed to implementing the necessary Health and Safety Guidelines for our staff and families.

Program Content:

What type of activities are planned?

Our Summer Camp program is committed to ensuring best youth development practices. We strive to put our efforts in giving our participants opportunities to take leadership roles, build healthy relationships with one another, encourage growth, develop a wide variety of interests through a range of activities and lessons, and mentor our youth to become well-rounded and socially conscious individuals.



Our curriculum is project-based and is designed around weekly themes such as Ocean or Space week. Thematic programming helps to keep kids interested and build skills around a specific topic. Each week will be differently themed. Activities include STEM projects, community building, service learning, Chinese language and culture, arts and crafts, outdoor recreation, games and songs.

Field trips will also take place such as the beach and areas in Golden Gate Park. We will also plan fun events such as picnics, a performance showcase, and camping trip for our 3rd-6th grade participants.

Cantonese Learning Component

Based on the theme of the week, participants will become familiar with Cantonese vocabulary, characters, and speaking practice related to the theme. Activities and day to day instructions will be led in English and Cantonese, students will be encouraged to practice speaking Cantonese though no prior Cantonese language experience is necessary.

Will lunch be provided?

Parents/Guardians will need to provide a daily lunch to their child/children. If you have any concerns about providing a meal to your child/children, please let us know so that we may be available to offer assistance.

Wah Mei School will be able to provide an afternoon snack on a daily basis as part of the program. If you have any type of food restrictions or allergies please let us know in advance, to the start of the program.

Please be sure to have your child/children bring a water bottle every day. We will have water available on site for our participants to refill water bottles.

Outdoor Time

WMS Summer Camp believes in Outdoor play, learning about urban environments, ecology, and conservation. We may have outdoor trips to a variety of locales.
